



St Paul's Camberley is a charismatic evangelical Anglican church on Crawley Ridge, with a clear focus on **Bible-based teaching ("Word") and Spirit-led worship ("Spirit")**, alongside a strong culture of **prayer and community**. Their vision is to play their part in seeing God transform lives locally helping people encounter God, find hope, and grow as disciples through worship, teaching, and shared church life.

The church meets every Sunday (typically **9:00am and 10:30am**) and aims to be welcoming to people at every stage of faith—encouraging visitors to come as they are, ask questions, and explore at their own pace. There's an active children's and youth programme alongside the 10:30am service, and midweek **Life Groups** that help people build friendships, study the Bible, and pray together in a more informal setting.

A key part of how St Paul's lives this out is through **mission giving** and **Children of the Dump is explicitly included within that mission and charitable giving**, as one of the overseas mission societies they give to.
