Based in Swansea, the Austin Bailey Foundation is a grant-making charity guided by the principle of “sharing with others that which we enjoy.” It supports registered charities and churches both locally and internationally, with a clear focus on practical help that strengthens wellbeing and opens up opportunity for people facing hardship.

Internationally, the Foundation funds relief and development work that tackles poverty and ill-health and helps young people and families move towards greater stability. Support is provided through a combination of smaller grants and, where appropriate, larger multi-year awards—recognising that sustained funding can enable deeper, longer-lasting outcomes and give partner organisations the confidence to plan effectively.

The Foundation’s giving is rooted in careful stewardship and a commitment to work alongside organisations that demonstrate integrity, compassion, and measurable impact. By supporting trusted partners, the Austin Bailey Foundation seeks to bring hope, dignity, and practical support to those who need it most—both in Swansea and beyond.
