The Barbara Ward Children's Foundation (BWCF) is a UK-registered, grant-making charity that exists to help severely disadvantaged children—in the UK and around the world—through carefully targeted funding. BWCF focuses on supporting smaller, non-religious charities where a well-placed grant can make a tangible difference, particularly when statutory funding is unlikely to be available.

BWCF's impact is global as well as local, it has made grants across the UK and in many countries worldwide—including the Philippines—always with the aim of improving children's lives in situations of serious disadvantage.

BWCF has supported Children of the Dump through grant funding because the charity's work closely matches the Foundation's purpose: helping severely disadvantaged children in situations of extreme need. By awarding grants (via ASCT, the UK charity linked to the Manila programmes), BWCF has been able to back practical, life-changing support for children living in extreme poverty—many from families surviving by scavenging in and around former rubbish-dump communities—so they can access care, protection and education, and have a safer, more hopeful future.
