

The Paget Charitable Trust



The Paget Charitable Trust (formally The Joanna Herbert Stepney Charitable Settlement, Charity No. 327402) is a UK grant-making trust that supports a wide range of charitable causes through donations to organisations working for public benefit.

Established by Deed of Settlement dated 25 June 1986 and registered with the Charity Commission in 1987, the Trust's charitable objects are deliberately broad, giving the trustees discretion to apply income (and, where appropriate, capital) to such charitable purposes and institutions as they consider fit.

The Trust's income is generated through the rental of land and property alongside the management of an investment portfolio, with these assets held specifically to create funds for charitable giving. Day-to-day management is undertaken by professional agents under the trustees' instruction.

In its grant-making, the Paget Charitable Trust supports work across areas including general charitable purposes, education and training, the prevention or relief of poverty, overseas aid and famine relief, animals, and environment/conservation/heritage. It is listed as operating within Leicestershire and throughout London, and it makes grants to help charities deliver practical, meaningful outcomes for the people and communities they serve.

Through careful stewardship of its resources and a commitment to responsive giving, the Paget Charitable Trust helps sustain organisations tackling need in many forms—supporting both immediate relief and longer-term improvement in lives and opportunities
