

Church and Faith Community Ambassador

Purpose

To help build links with churches and faith communities, sharing the charity's Christian foundation and encouraging prayer, giving, sponsorship and practical support.

Key responsibilities

- Introduce Children of the Dump to churches, small groups and faith communities.
- Arrange short talks after services or at church meetings, using approved materials.
- Encourage prayer, donations, child sponsorship and volunteering.
- Share updates for church newsletters, noticeboards or social media pages.
- Help organise Lent, Harvest, Advent or Christmas appeals where appropriate.
- Keep the Charity Manager updated about church contacts and possible opportunities.

Person specification

- Someone with church links, faith community networks or confidence speaking to small groups.
- Able to explain the charity's work in a warm, respectful and non-pressurising way.
- Sensitive to different church traditions and local contexts.
- Organised and reliable in following up with contacts.
- Committed to the charity's values and the children and families we support.

Time commitment

Flexible. This may involve occasional talks, a few emails or phone calls each month, and extra time around seasonal appeals.
