

Community Fundraising Volunteer

Purpose

To organise or support small fundraising activities in your local area, helping more people discover and support the work of Children of the Dump.

Key responsibilities

- Arrange simple fundraising activities such as coffee mornings, quizzes, sponsored walks, curry nights, bake sales or afternoon teas.
- Encourage churches, schools, clubs, workplaces and community groups to support the charity.
- Help promote existing appeals and campaigns locally.
- Share approved information about the charity in a clear and respectful way.
- Collect simple stories and photos from events, where appropriate, for charity updates and social media.
- Keep in touch with the Charity Manager about plans, money raised and follow-up thank-yous.

Person specification

- Friendly, reliable and comfortable bringing people together.
- Organised enough to plan a small event or activity.
- Able to talk about the charity warmly and sensitively.
- Willing to follow charity guidance on fundraising, safeguarding, photos and use of the charity name.
- No previous fundraising experience is needed, although it is welcome.

Time commitment

Flexible. This could be a few hours for a one-off activity, or a few hours each month if you would like to support regular local fundraising.
