Purpose

To give short talks about Children of the Dump and help more people understand the charity's work and how they can support it.

Key responsibilities

- Speak at churches, Rotary clubs, schools, WI groups, workplaces or community events.
- Use an approved slide deck and up-to-date charity information.
- Share the charity's story clearly, warmly and respectfully.
- Answer basic questions and signpost more detailed enquiries to the Charity Manager.
- Encourage sponsorship, donations, volunteering or fundraising where appropriate.
- Feed back any useful contacts, questions or opportunities after each talk.

Person specification

- Confident speaking to small or medium-sized groups.
- Warm, approachable and comfortable meeting new people.
- Able to represent the charity in a respectful and sensitive way.
- Reliable in preparing for talks and following agreed charity messages.
- Previous public speaking experience is helpful but not essential.

Time commitment

Occasional and flexible. Time will depend on the number of talks agreed, including preparation and travel where needed.
