Purpose

To help Children of the Dump build respectful, meaningful links with Filipino communities in the UK.

Key responsibilities

- Connect with Filipino community groups, churches, cultural associations or local networks in the UK.
- Introduce the charity sensitively and respectfully, explaining its work with children and families in Manila.
- Identify community events where the charity could be represented or shared.
- Support culturally relevant fundraising ideas, events or awareness activities.
- Help the charity listen and learn from Filipino community contacts.
- Build long-term relationships based on trust, respect and shared concern for children in the Philippines.

Person specification

- Someone with Filipino community connections, cultural understanding or strong relationship-building skills.
- Warm, respectful and confident speaking with community contacts.
- Able to represent the charity in a sensitive and non-tokenistic way.
- Organised enough to keep in touch and follow up opportunities.
- Committed to building relationships, not just short-term fundraising.

Time commitment

Flexible. This could be a few hours a month, with occasional extra time around community events or fundraising opportunities.
