

One-off Volunteer Opportunities

Purpose

To offer practical ways for people to support Children of the Dump even if they cannot commit to a regular volunteering role.

Key responsibilities

- Host a fundraising event such as a quiz night, coffee morning, cake sale, sponsored walk, charity concert or Christmas fair stall.
- Run a birthday, anniversary, retirement, wedding or celebration fundraiser in support of the charity.
- Offer a short professional skills session, such as help with design, website review, SEO, Mailchimp, safeguarding wording, fundraising law or finance processes.
- Create content for one campaign, such as Canva graphics, short reels or a simple appeal pack.
- Organise a workplace fundraising day, raffle, lunch-and-learn talk, walking challenge or matched giving appeal.
- Introduce the charity to one useful contact, such as a church leader, school, business owner, Rotary or Lions club, Filipino community group, journalist or grant-making trust contact.

Person specification

- Supporters, families, students, churches, workplaces or community groups who want to help in a practical way.
- People who may only have a small amount of time but want to make a real contribution.
- Anyone with a useful skill, contact, idea or opportunity to share.
- Able to work with the charity's guidance on fundraising, safeguarding and communications.
- Willing to keep the charity updated so support can be acknowledged properly.

Time commitment

Flexible. A one-off activity could take a few hours, a single day or a short project period, depending on what you choose to do.
