

School and Youth Group Volunteer

Purpose

To help build links with schools, youth groups, Scouts, Guides, universities, Sunday schools and other young people's groups.

Key responsibilities

- Support simple assemblies, talks or classroom activities using approved resources.
- Encourage "children helping children" fundraising in schools and youth groups.
- Help organise non-uniform days, sponsored challenges, collections or awareness activities.
- Support teachers and leaders with simple lesson ideas around poverty, education and global citizenship.
- Share appropriate updates with schools and groups that choose to support the charity.
- Work with the Charity Manager to ensure all materials are suitable, respectful and safeguarding-aware.

Person specification

- Retired teachers, youth workers, parents, students or education professionals would be especially suited to this role.
- Comfortable communicating with schools, group leaders or young people's organisations.
- Able to keep information simple, age-appropriate and respectful.
- Organised, reliable and able to follow agreed charity guidance.
- Enthusiastic about helping children in the UK learn about children in Manila.

Time commitment

Flexible. This could be occasional support for one school or group, or a few hours a month building new links.
